### Overview:

[Be Internet Awesome](#) is Google's free multifaceted program designed to teach kids the fundamentals of digital citizenship and safety so they can explore the online world with confidence. The program is available in English and Spanish and consists of an ISTE standards-aligned curriculum, ready-to-teach Pear Decks for each lesson, [Interland](#) - an adventure-packed online game about digital safety and citizenship - and plenty of resources for [educators](#) and [families](#).

The program has five fundamental topics of online safety and digital citizenship from the Internet Code of Awesome:

Pillar	Topic
Be Internet <b>Smart</b> : Share with Care	Online Reputation
Be Internet <b>Alert</b> : Don't Fall for Fake	Phishing, Scams, & Credible Sources
Be Internet <b>Strong</b> : Secure Your Secrets	Privacy & Security
Be Internet <b>Kind</b> : It's Cool to Be Kind	Online Harassment
Be Internet <b>Brave</b> : When in Doubt, Talk It Out	Questionable & Inappropriate Content
